Shippers: Entities shipping or receiving goods	
Membership Investment Based on Tons Shipped or Received:	
Apply a rate of .5 cents per ton	
Shipper/Receiver Minimum	\$2,500
Shipper Maximum	\$50,000
Carriers: Boat and barge operators	
Sixty percent of AWO dues formula	
Note: Shipper-owned carriers pay carrier dues in addition to the dues paid by the shipper.	
Waterway Services: Entities providing services to shippers, carriers, or any water related organizations
