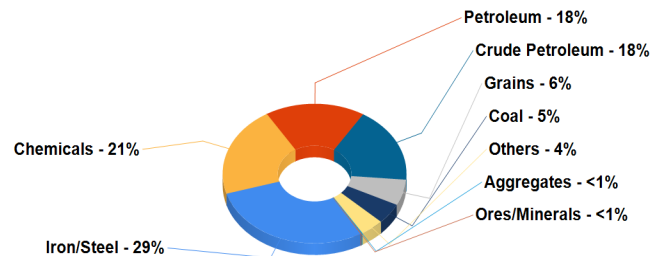

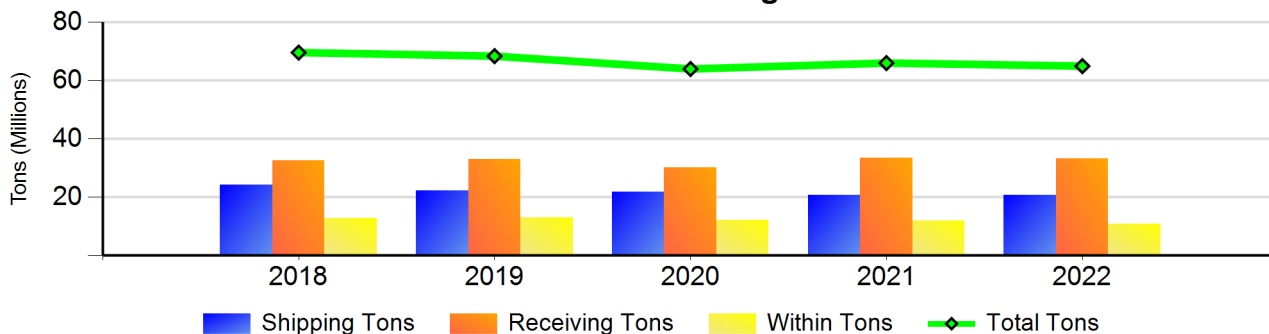
2022 All Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

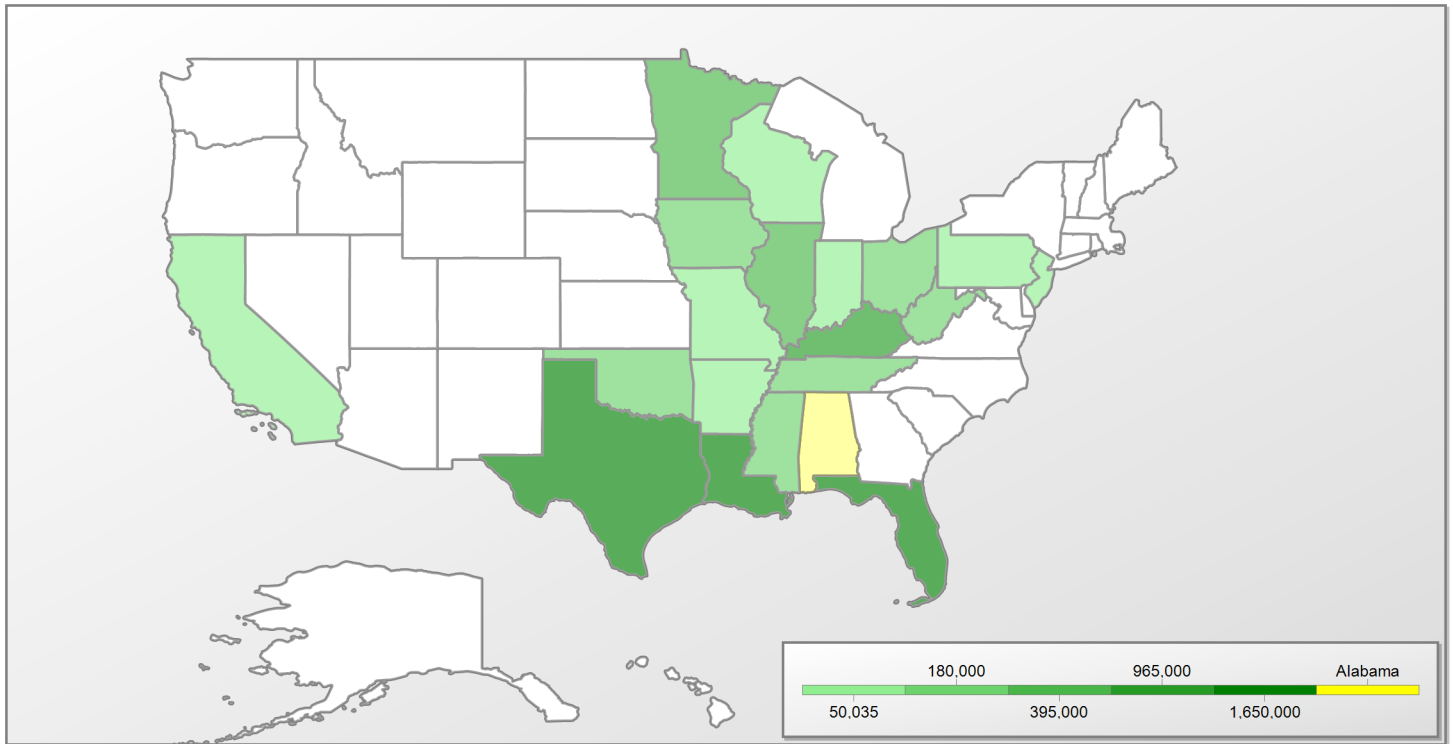

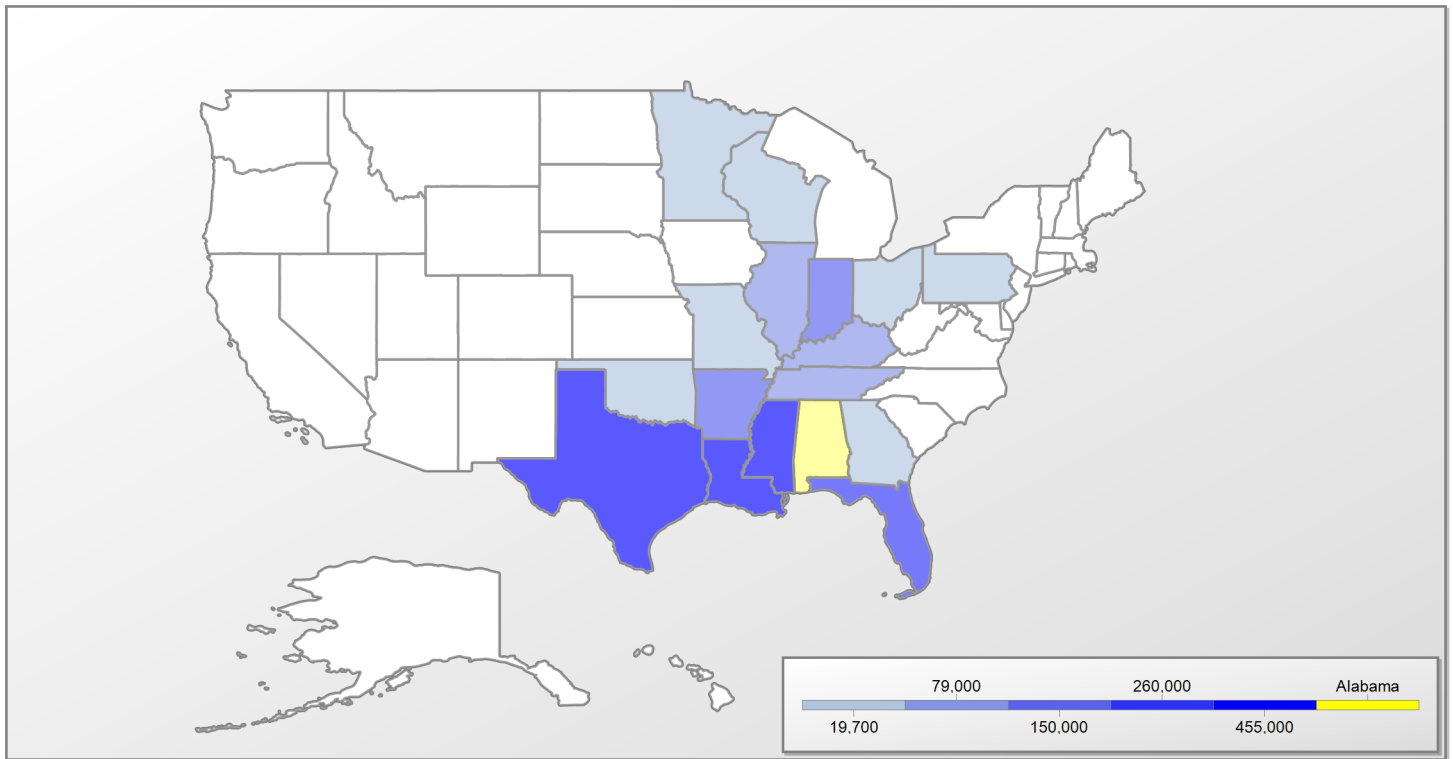

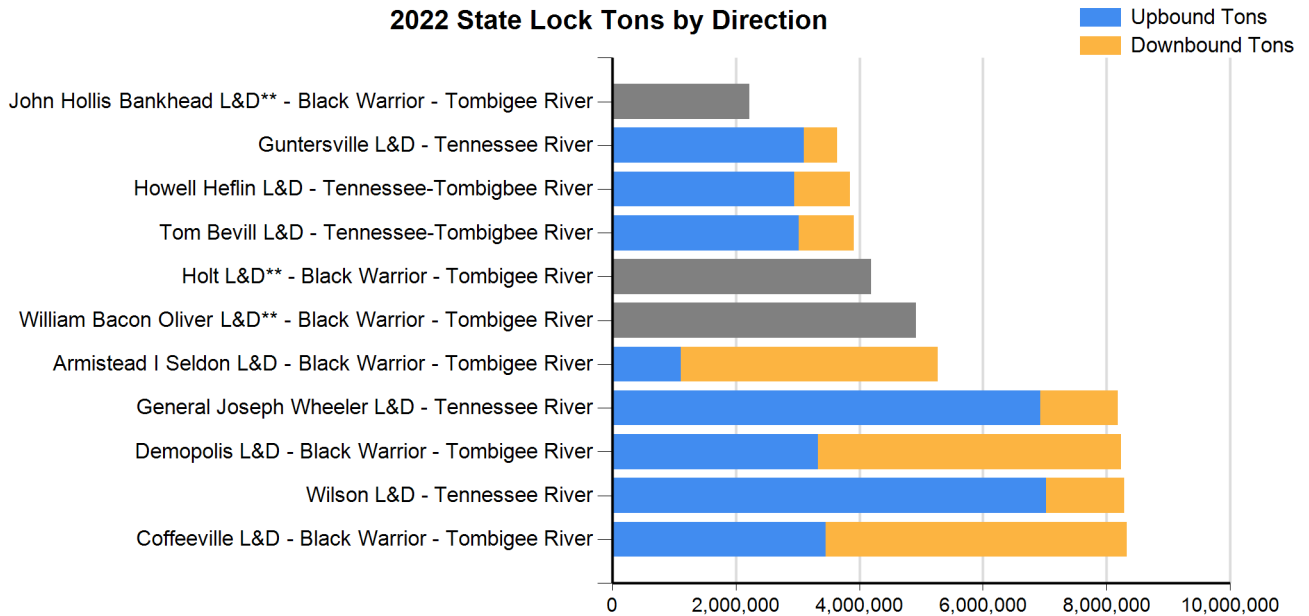

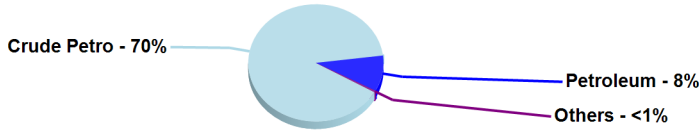

2022 Coastal Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

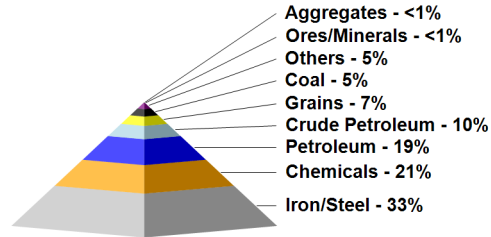
